The establishment of Barangay Food Terminal nationwide (BFT) is DA's response to the call for government agencies to implement projects under the Accelerated Hunger Mitigation Program (AHMP). The BFT project enables farmers to establish a direct and effective farm-to-consumer food supply chain. On the other hand, Municipal Food Terminals (MFTs) provide the farmers a market for the bulk of their produce without passing through a multi-layered marketing system that puts the farmers most of the time at the losing end.
