
NEDA envisions the country where public and private sectors perform their respective roles efficiently, such that people have equal access to opportunities, resulting in inclusive development and zero poverty.

ABOUT NEDA

The National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA), as mandated by the Philippine Constitution, is the government's independent socioeconomic planning body.

NEDA's beginning can be traced back to 1935, when the Commonwealth Act created the National Economic Council (NEC). The NEC had undergone various reconstitutions and integrations with other economic councils through Presidential Decree 107, which then established NEDA.

It was reorganized on July 22, 1987, in accordance with Executive Order No. 230, to enhance its ability to coordinate the development planning and policy formulation process.

ORGANIZATION

NEDA consists of the NEDA Board and the NEDA Secretariat. The NEDA Board is the governing body that sets major development policy directions for the Philippines, while the NEDA Secretariat serves as its research and technical support arm.

NEDA BOARD

The NEDA Board is composed of the President as Chair, the NEDA Secretary as Vice-Chair, and designated department secretaries as members.

Assisting the NEDA Board are seven cabinet-level inter-agency committees:

- Development Budget Coordination Committee;
- Committee on Infrastructure;
- Investment Coordination Committee;
- Social Development Committee;
- Committee on Tariff and Related Matters;
- Regional Development Committee; and
- National Land Use Committee.

NEDA SECRETARIAT

The NEDA Secretariat, headed by the NEDA Secretary, is regarded as the authority in macroeconomic forecasting, and policy analysis and research. It provides high-level policy advice to the Executive and Legislative branches of government.

The Secretariat is tasked to:



Coordinate activities such as the formulation of policies, plans, and programs to efficiently set the broad parameters for national and sub-national (area-wide, regional, and local) development;



Review, monitor, and evaluate infrastructure projects identified under the Comprehensive and Integrated Infrastructure Program consistent with the government's thrust of increasing investment spending for the growing demand on quality infrastructure facilities; and



Undertake critical analyses of development issues and provide policy alternatives to decision-makers.
