<sup>1</sup>The Harmonized Gender and Development Guidelines (HGDG) is a tool in monitoring the gender-responsiveness of ODA programs and projects in terms of its design, implementation, management, monitoring and evaluation. The total cost attributed to GAD is determined by assessing a project's level of gender responsiveness using the PIMME checklist. The total project cost is multiplied by the PIMME score over the highest possible score of 20.
